# Presidential Preference Vote Ballot Selection and Marking Instructions April 2, 2024

The Presidential Preference Vote is your opportunity to express to one party of your choice which candidate you recommend becoming that party's Presidential candidate.

#### 1. Choose a party:

You may only vote on **ONE** party's ballot. If you vote on more than one party's ballot, your votes will not count.

- ✓ Choose ONE party ballot on which to vote
- ✓ Remove your selected party's ballot from the packet

#### 2. Vote for ONE candidate on your selected ballot:

If you vote more than once, your choices will not be counted.

On the ballot you selected, you have ONE of three choices:

- ✓ Vote for a candidate whose
- vote for an uninstructed delegation from Wisconsin to the national convention of the party you have chosen.

### 3. If you make a mistake or have a question:

## 4. Cast your ballot:

- ✓ When you're finished voting, place the party ballot you voted on in the ballot box
