## 8. Discuss NORSTAR phone tree

Chief Deputy Alex Walrath requests approval to implement a NORSTAR phone tree at the Sheriff's Department. Initial cost of the equipment and installation is \$1,102.00. This cost will be offset by the monthly fee of \$81.00 for the current voicemail package that will be removed from the monthly phone bill. Initial cost of the equipment will be returned in 13.6 months, then an \$81.00 per month savings to the county. E. Huettl recommended the initial cost be paid using Title III funds.

Humane Society Vice President Albert Thompson appeared at the Sheriff & Justice meeting to discuss Ordinance #04-2012 pertaining to the impoundment of dogs. Albert questioned who would pay for the cost of impounding dogs related to veterinary and other bills. The matter was discussed and a decision was made to find out what amount of money is generated by the dog license fees in the townships and municipalities. Chief Deputy Walrath volunteered to research the amount of revenue generated by the dog licenses and discuss the matter with Corporation counsel.
