- 1) Meeting called to order by Chairman Lukas @ 7:00 P.M.
- 2) Roll Call: Lukas, LeMaster, and Connors, also in attendance were Co. Bd. Chairman Millan, Co. Supervisor Chaney, and Mr. Bob Schultheis
- 3) Motion by Connors, seconded by LeMaster, to approve the agenda as read. Motion carried unanimously.
- 4) Motion by LeMaster, seconded by Connors, to approve the minutes from the May 28, 2014, meeting. Motion carried unanimously.
- 5) Mr. Bob Schultheis appeared before the Committee to express his concerns for the speed limit on County Highway "S" between State Hwy 55 and U.S. Hwy 8 in the Town of Nashville. He was also concerned with the noise from heavy trucks using their engine braking systems to slow down. Mr. Schultheis was informed that he would need to approach the Nashville Town Board to discuss a noise ordinance for the area he is concerned with. Mr. Schultheis was also informed that the Committee would look into the speed limit, which is currently 55 MPH, in that area.
