UPDATE ON VET CENTER GREEN BAY TRAINING

There has been communication between Todd Stage and the Sheriff's Department. Todd will be coming to Forest County November 5 or 6 to complete training on PTSD with the Sheriff's Department employees. Right now this training will only be available to the Forest County Sheriff's Department. Maybe sometime in the future there can be training available to some of the different posts throughout Forest County.

MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT IDEA

The Veterans that are being reimbursed by the VA Facilities are now reimbursing the Veterans' Office if they weren't already. They are now more aware of the mileage reimbursement process. This has helped decrease the amount of money being withdrawn from the mileage budget. The VSO is also looking at assessing the Veteran's household income to determine if he/she is financially capable of paying some portion of the expense spent on their transportation to their medical appointment. The VSO has talked to the Iron Mountain Van Service and the van service has agreed to pick up Veterans who live in Laona and east of Laona to take them to their medical appointments. There is a transit commission through Headwaters coming that will serve the Forest County area. This should help decrease the mileage/transportation budget.
