Sheriff Dennee expressed his concern to the committee about losing the experience and that is very hard to replace. He stated that he understands tough budgets, but his fear is that losing the experience may hurt us in the long run. He asks that the Board start changing the mindset when it comes to compensating our good long term employees or if they agree, to start implementing changes for compensation.

Sheriff Dennee also informed the Committee that Brown Co will no longer contract out Juvenile beds and that effective Oct 1<sup>st</sup> 2016, they will no longer guarantee the bed day rate of \$110.00. He explained that Brown Co Juvenile Detention is full and having trouble guaranteeing beds.
