Family Care Update- Paul Millan stated that RFP has been sent out by the State to the Managed Care Organizations (MCO). The MCOs have until mid- November to submit their request to the State. Paul indicated that the State is saying by mid- 2017, everything should be set for the remaining counties who are moving into Family Care; and Dane county going over in 2018. Paul also stated that the State will begin the monthly meetings with the remaining counties as they said in the next month. There was a discussion about concerns that clients will not get the same service of care and that clients are starting to ask questions and having their own concerns of what to expect moving into Family Care.
