

## **LEPC Meeting Minutes**

**March 22, 2018**

The March 22, 2018 meeting of the Forest County Local Emergency Planning Committee was **called to Order** at 1:34 p.m. by Chairman Gerorge Stamper.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

**Discussion of Letter sent by WEM reference Membership Vacancy** – Jason explained that this was a error in reporting to the state. It was found that in the Hazard plan all members were listed but on the transmittal sheet 2 members were missing. This error was taken care of and new transmittal was sent to state.

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

**Checking with Snow River about being reporting facility** – Advised that Jason will be working with Teresa (State Regional WEM) and making a visit to the facilities later this summer.

**Hazmat Grant Question from Jill** – Was advised that it is still available and that it is being used to purchase hazmat equipment for Oneida Hazmat to satisfy the \$5000.00 yearly contract. Also advised that the other half of the grant for computers, that equipment is to stay in EM office or for the EOC.

**Question about MARC Repeater** – Advised that this equipment is located at the Crandon Fire Station and is available for county operations as it is County Owned. Repeater is in the Brush truck of Crandon Fire and can be paged out.

### **OTHER BUSINESS:**

**Question about New 911** – advised that county has authorized the purchase of the new 911 software for the county. First option is Zuercher Technologies, second option is West (Viper). Were advised that we are getting a new updated quote to have 3 stations in the dispatch.

**Firstnet** – Jason advised the committee of the Governor opting in with Firstnet and explained what the future plans are about with this new wireless technology would offer to Fire/EMS/Police.

**MABAS/New Dispatch** – Mike asked when the new dispatch center was built, would we be utilizing MABAS at this time. Jason advised him that the Sheriff has said that he is for using MABAS when we would be moved into the new dispatch. Being a separate dispatch from the jail would have less distractions.
