CONDUCT CANVASS OF THE APRIL 3, 2018, SPRING ELECTION

Town of Alvin-Ward 1 – Total number of voters 27. No outstanding provisional ballots.

Town of Argonne-Ward 1 – Total number of voters 26. No outstanding provisional ballots, did not separate voters by ward.

Town of Argonne-Ward 2 – Total number of voters 105. No outstanding provisional ballots, did not separate voters by ward.

Town of Argonne-Ward 3- Total number of voters 17. No outstanding provisional ballots, did not separate voters by ward.

Town of Armstrong Creek-Ward 1 – Total number of voters 161. No outstanding provisional ballots.

Town of Blackwell-Ward 1 – Total number of voters 23. No outstanding provisional ballots.

Town of Caswell-Ward 1 - Total number of voters 17. No outstanding provisional ballots. Tally sheet is missing last vote on poll list. Inspector's statement is missing tamper evident seal serial number and memory device serial number and the poll book does not have any signatures in it, just numbers.

Town of Crandon-Ward 1- Total number of voters 99. No outstanding provisional ballots. There were 100 voters in Ward 1 in the poll book, but, Al Thompson voted in the wrong ward, he voted in ward 2. The wards were not separated in the poll book, voter number 42 was used twice and there was not a number 100. The poll book was re-numbered after the original numbers were put in. The voting machine was turned on at 6:45 a.m. and 2 votes were cast before 7:00 a.m. The Pre-Lat cartridge was voted on instead of the Official cartridge for the election.

Town of Crandon- Ward 2- Total number of voters 21. No outstanding provisional ballots. There were a total of 20 voters in the poll book, but, Al Thompson from Ward 1 voted in Ward 2, which was recorded in the votes that were cast 18 machine tally and 3 paper ballots.
