She has tried to come up with a budget that would work without the integration but right now it could not be done and she was short around \$15,000. In the packet there was three separate organizational charts that Poe came up with that she felt would work.

DISCUSSION WITH TAMMY QUEEN ON COMMISSION ON AGING AND SERVICES PROVIDED

Queen explained what services the Aging offers and her thoughts on the integration as well as the clients both agencies serviced. Queen did not think the Aging Department would benefit from the integration.
