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1. **Call to Order:** The call to order was given by Chairman Karl Tauer at 4:30 p.m. in room 107 of the Forest County Courthouse.

3. **Approval of the Agenda:** Motion by Scott Goode, to approve the agenda, Second by Ron Karl. All in favor, motion approved.

7. **Discussion and Possible Action on Metallic Mining Ordinance:** Jeannie informed the committee that she had contacted Karl Jennrich from Oneida County and Lane Loveland from Marathon County regarding the County's jurisdiction regarding a countywide mining ordinance.
