# APPROVE MINUTES OF THE OCTOBER 30, 2019 JOINT PERSONNEL & FINANCE MEETING AND THE OCTOBER 18<sup>TH,</sup> AND OCTOBER 16<sup>TH</sup>, FINANCE MEETINGS

Motion by Chaney to approve the minutes of the October 30, 2019 Joint Personnel & Finance Meeting, second by Stamper. All present voting (AYE). Motion carried. ### DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON RECOMMENDATION FROM THE SOCIAL SERVICES COMMITTEE TO APPROVE HOLIDAY PAY FOR A REGULAR, PART-TIME EMPLOYEE

Motion by Stamper to follow the handbook and deny the holiday pay, as the employee is only a part-time employee, second by Chaney. All present voting (AYE.) Motion carried.

## DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON AMENDMENTS TO THE PROPOSED 2020 BUDGET SUMMARY FOR THE ADDITIONAL WAGES
