CALL TO ORDER

Black called the meeting to order at 4:07 p.m. and read the agenda.

APPROVE MINUTES FROM THE JUNE 8, 2020 MEETING

Motion by Dailey to approve the minutes from the June 8, 2020 meeting, second by Collins. All present voting (AYE). Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Burl asked about the Covid-19 related death and why it was reported late. Shepard explained that it was not communicated to the Health Department by the Medical Examiner that the death was Covid-19 related. It was changed in WEDSS by someone at state, based on the Medical Examiner's report. There have been emails and phone calls between the Health Department and Medical Examiner's office to try and prevent this from happening again. There is a PHAVR report that the Health Department can run daily to see what data DHS has for our county.

COVID-19 UPDATES

Shepard shared that 39 people were tested at the Community Testing event with the National Guard, not all Forest County residents. All those results were negative. Shepard also shared that DPI put out guidance for school reopening. The Health Department has had calls with CESA 8 and local superintendents to discuss future plans. Dailey shared that Nicolet College has chosen to continue with virtual classes only into the Fall semester. Shepard shared that DHS has a new Data Dashboard on their website, it shows Forest County as 'high' due to amount of cases based on population. Collins made a motion to keep the Security Guard at the front door until July 31st and review at that time, seconded by Burl, all ayes, motion carried. Shepard shared signage to possibly use for the court system reopening. Collins made a motion to approve the signs, Gretzinger seconded, all ayes, motion carried.
