EBS REPORT

Kathy O'Melia presented the EBS report.

- She reported that she has completed a number of trainings, which helped her with Medicare sign-up.
- DHS expects the public health emergency to last until the end of 2021.
- No one may be taken off of a Medicaid program during the emergency.

BUDGET UPDATES

Queen presented the budget update.

- A year's worth of funding will be received by the Commission on Aging from the American Rescue Funds (stimulus funds), to be used over a three-year period.
- Funding will also be received for vaccination campaigning.
- Forest County must match 25% of fund received.
- In-kind hours from volunteers can be put toward the match.

NUTRITION PROGRAM UPDATE

REOPENING OF CONGREGATE MEAL SITES UPDATE

- Reopening of congregate sites went well. Fifty-one percent of nutrition program participants are taking home-delivered meals or carry-out.
- ALVIN MEAL SITE UPDATE
 - o Tammy Wolfe is new meal site manager. The plan is to open on September 9, 2021. Wolfe is being trained by Queen and is in the process of getting needed licensure.
