DISCUSS HEROIN AND METHAMPHETAMINE GRANT REIMBURSEMENTS

Chief Deputy Walrath advised the committee that a partial reimbursement for the Drug Task Force overtime was received from the Methamphetamine and Heroin grants. The grants are through NORDEG and overseen by the Oneida Co. Sheriff's Officer. The methamphetamine reimbursement was \$1605.47 and the heroin reimbursement was \$2671.07.
