CONDUCT CANVASS OF THE APRIL 5, 2022, SPRING ELECTION

Two EDRs recorded on Inspectors' Statement and two voters signed the supplemental poll list, one voter did not vote, not noted on the incident log. Page 8 of the poll book has two voters with no voter number.
