Brad Bessert wanted to bring up the Public Service Commission website and all of the information a person can get off the website as well as sign up for email newsletter updates. He said there are two grants right now that were for establishing the middle mile.

Lukas wondered if the USDA Rural Development, who is hiring staff to write grants could be used for Broadband grants. Stark felt these grant writers would be used for the housing situation, not economic growth. He wanted to talk about the billion dollar grants out there for the middle mile. He said the grant has "27 hoops" that you have to get through to get them. They would have to drop everything to work on the grants because one (1) is due on September 30th, and it is not a good idea stop working on everything else for it. There are other grants they are working on.

For future grants the county needs to get the MAP data out first. Littleton said they would be working on another round of speed tests.

REPORT FROM EM DIRECTOR AND DEPUTY LIO ON WHAT WAS LEARNED AT THE REGIONAL BROADBAND MEETING

UW-Extension Amber Rehberg also attended the meeting. Statezny told the committee, broadband carriers were there, Charter, Astea and Bug Tussel. She said they all updated the counties on where they were and progress of projects. They spoke of Boulder Junction and how they were considered a "pilot program" and were successful with their Broadband project.

REPORT STATUS FROM BUG TUSSEL (MARK DODGE)

Mark Dodge and Jason Weid were present from Bug Tussel with an update on the current project Forest County has with Northwoods Connect. They explained some difficulties they have encountered with the past company and are working very hard to move forward to get the project done in time. They know there are two (2) areas not going to be finished and they will have to file for an extension for them. Some of the issue was with supply, but they have assured it will be completed. Right now, there are currently 1200 customers signed up in Forest County for the internet service. The second phase they have already done the engineering and will have to be completed by the end of 2024.

Dodge brought in a progress binder for the current project and will be supplying monthly updates for both projects when the agreement for the second project is signed and they can proceed.
