# LAND CONSERVATION

a. There was a discussion on the Land Management Plan Direction for Old Growth Forest Conditions across the National Forest System given by Mike Brown, District Ranger. The Forest Service is currently working through the National Environmental Planning Act process to develop an Environmental Impact Statement. The National Old Growth Amendment process is anticipated to be completed in early 2025 following intensive public scoping and analysis of comments. The draft of the National Old Growth Amendment will have a 90-day comment period, which should be out by June 1<sup>st</sup>, and Mr. Brown highly recommended that the LC-LI-GIS Committee respond during the 90-day comment period. No action taken at this time.

- b. There was a lengthy discussion on the PFAS lawsuit brought to us by Napoli Law. Motion at this time that the Land Conservation Land Information GIS Committee does not wish to withdraw from the litigation regarding the lawsuit brought to us by Napoli Law, and further request that any documents be forwarded for signatures made by Cindy Gretzinger, second by Ron Karl.
